1. **2019/20Feb/01 Apologies for Absence:** Nil

3. **2019/20Feb/03 Minutes:** It was resolved that the minutes (previously circulated) of the Ordinary Parish Council meeting held on 7th January 2020 be approved and signed by the Chairman as a true and accurate record.
4. **2019/20Feb/04 Matter arising** – Reported back email from P Long (WBC) that UU are to visit Kiln Lane on 17th Feb at 2pm
5. **2019/20Feb/05 Police related issues – Meeting was attended by Sergeant Guy Hamlet**

Items covered:

Local Policing restructure, Neighbourhood Policing retained in Wyre but not across the Country. Lancashire are using Taskforce Officers that can be deployed to meet need. Drug activity in Hambleton is relatively low.

Speeding – Lancashire Road Safety, Local Police are advisory rather than prosecuting

Knife Crime – Wyre is low risk and Hambleton very low risk. Operation Edge ie stop and search in high risk areas, working with the police but not run by Police. Police focussed on training and education in schools focussing on impact.

 - d) Returned BKV Shield. It was resolved that this be considered at the next In Bloom meeting.
8. **2019/20Feb/08 Reports of Meetings:**
 - a) **Village Hall Management Committee** It was reported that new strengthened Glass outside doors had been installed. Plans for main hall have changed now plan to remove ceiling and adding dimmable LED lighting and insulation. Supper room, adding insulation, checking radiators and removing thermostat valves
 - b) **Area LALC Meeting** Garry Payne attended. Reported that Wyre Borough Lottery starts on 18/2 with first draw 21/3. It was resolved that Clerk would register Hambleton Parish Council in Lottery.
 - a) **Wyre Flood Forum:** It was reported that Making Space for Water was met with concern and that flooding was caused by incorrect direction of water into sewer. Surveys are being carried out and the results will guide actions. There are plans to move water Northwards around the Coppins, due to start end of Jan. United Utilities are not obliged to respond to planning applications and they are obliged to manage sewerage from developments regardless. WBC can request that UU respond to

applications. LCC have produced a paper Strengthening Flood Risk Management. Mr O'Flaherty agreed to join the FLAG group

9. 2019/20Feb/09 Bob Williamson Park:

- a) Park development – Remedial work on paths in dog area has been carried out however weather is not helping.
- b) Pond Project – It was resolved that the Clerk would apply for some free trees from Woodland Trust
- c) Upcoming Working Group (8th February) – It was resolved that the group would focus on park woodland areas and drain clearing on Church Lane.
- d) Gym Equipment: Awaiting response from Fresh Air Fitness.
