**Minutes**

1. Chairman’s Welcome and Opening Remarks

Councillor Sycamore welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced those present. She thanked the Councillors for their support over the last year and welcomed the new Councillors. A thank was given to the Hambleton In Bloom volunteers and put out a call for others to join the group.

2. Open Forum – residents may raise any matters/concerns

A member of the public raised concerns about inconsiderate driving in the village and particularly on Market Street around the junction of Ingol Lane. It was mentioned that the issue was generally due to speeding and was bad at school start and end times. A further concern was the lack of road markings on the junction. The area was made a higher risk due to narrow pavements and a blind bend causing pedestrians to use the road especially when with a pram. It was reported that the wall at Ingol Cottage had been hit several times. It was further reported that pets had been killed and injured by cars in the area. LCC Councillor Nigel Aldersen reported that he was looking at roads in the area and would try to include Market Street.
